

By-Laws Yale Club of India

Article I OBJECT AND PURPOSE

The object of the association shall be to promote, foster and advance fellowship among alumni of Yale University, and to advance the interests, influence and reputation of Yale by establishing a medium for serving the University in India.

Article II MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. Any graduate, current student or International Affiliate of Yale University shall be eligible for membership in this association.

Members holding a degree from Yale University will be inducted as “Core Members” whereas others will be inducted as “Affiliate Members”. Only “Core Members” will have voting rights and be eligible to be members of the Board of Directors or Officers of this association. “Affiliate Members” will have limited rights and will not be eligible to vote or to be Directors or Officers of this association.

Section 2. The annual dues of this association shall be as determined by the Board of Directors.

Article III BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1. The policies of this association and the control and management of its affairs shall be vested in a board consisting of up to five (5) directors as follows: (a) three (3) directors elected as such by the membership and (b) as ex-officio directors, each of the persons holding the offices of Director and Chair, Alumni Schools Committee while holding such offices. Such three (3) directors shall be elected by the membership at the regular annual meeting hereinafter provided. Directors shall be elected every three years and serve for a term of three (3) years or until each such director’s successor shall have been elected and qualified.

Section 2. Vacancies on the Board of Directors shall be filled by a majority vote of the Board at a special meeting called for that purpose.

Section 3. Directors shall function as a board, and shall adopt such rules and regulations for the conduct of their meetings as they may deem proper, not inconsistent with these by-laws.

Section 4. A quorum at any meeting of directors shall consist of two (2) directors.

Article IV OFFICERS

Section 1. The officers of the association shall be a President, Vice-President and Director and such other positions as the Board of Directors shall determine. The officers shall be elected every three years by the Board of Directors following the regular annual meeting of the membership. The President, Vice-President and Director shall be members of the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Officers shall serve from the time of their respective elections until the third anniversary of such election or until their successors have been elected and qualified. Any officer may be removed either with or without cause by a majority vote of the Board of Directors at a special meeting called for that purpose or at the annual meeting, and vacancies among the officers shall be filled by the Board of Directors without undue delay.

Section 3. The officers of the association shall serve as an Executive Committee for the conduct and management of the affairs of the association, together with such additional members as may from time to time be appointed by the Board of Directors.

Section 4. The officers shall perform all duties normally incident to their respective offices.

Article V MEETINGS

Section 1. The regular annual meeting of the membership of this association shall be held in the month of February at a time and place to be set by the Board of Directors. Notice of such annual meetings shall be mailed to members at least five (5) days prior to the date thereof.

Section 2. Meeting of the association shall be held at times and places to be determined by the Board of Directors.

Section 3. Meetings of the Board of Directors and of the officers shall be held at such times and places to be determined by their respective memberships.

Section 4. The President, and in his absence the Vice-President, shall preside at all meetings of the membership, the Board of Directors and the officers.

Section 5. Procedure at all business meetings shall be conducted according to Roberts' Rules of Order Revised.

Article VI COMMITTEES

Section 1. The President, with the approval of the Board of Directors, shall appoint such committees as necessary to carry out the aims and objectives of this association and to properly administer its affairs.

Section 2. At least three (3) weeks prior to the time of holding the membership meeting, the President, with the approval of the Board of Directors, shall appoint a nominating committee which in turn shall present its nominations of candidates for election as members of the Board of Directors at the annual meeting.

Article VII FISCAL YEAR

The fiscal year of the association shall be from April 1st to March 31st of each year.

Article VIII AMENDMENTS

These by-laws may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the whole Board of Directors present and voting.
